1 // SINGLE TOOTH REPLACEMENT



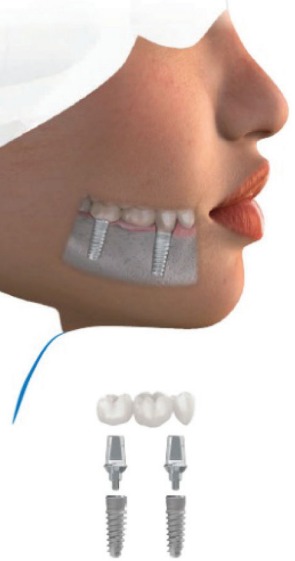
If you are missing a single tooth, an implant-supported crown is many times the recommended treatment.

2 // MULTIPLE TOOTH REPLACEMENT WITH A FIXED BRIDGE



When few adjacent teeth are missing or badly damaged, implant-supported bridge may be the right solution. This advantageous treatment avoids damaging adjacent teeth for a teeth-supported bridge, or the use of a partial removable denture.

Treatment with dental implants leads to better esthetics and function, with no harm to adjacent teeth. The result is a more convenient solution that enhances quality of life while keeping your remaining teeth healthy.

3 // SUPPORT AND RETENTION OF A REMOVABLE COMPLETE DENTURE



Poorly fitting dentures were found to affect not only the ability to chew and speak, but also patients' self-esteem.

Two to four dental implants with attachments or a bar keep the denture firmly in place, enhancing your quality of life and enabling you to eat, laugh and smile with confidence at any situation.

- Holds the denture in place
- Helps prevent bone loss and jawline recession by replacing the tooth root
- A fixed solution, that provides comfort and security in knowing that the denture won't dislodge
- Restores talking and chewing ability better than a removable denture that has no implants support
- Easier maintenance and better hygiene compared to a fixed bridge/denture

4 // A FIXED FULL DENTURE ON IMPLANTS

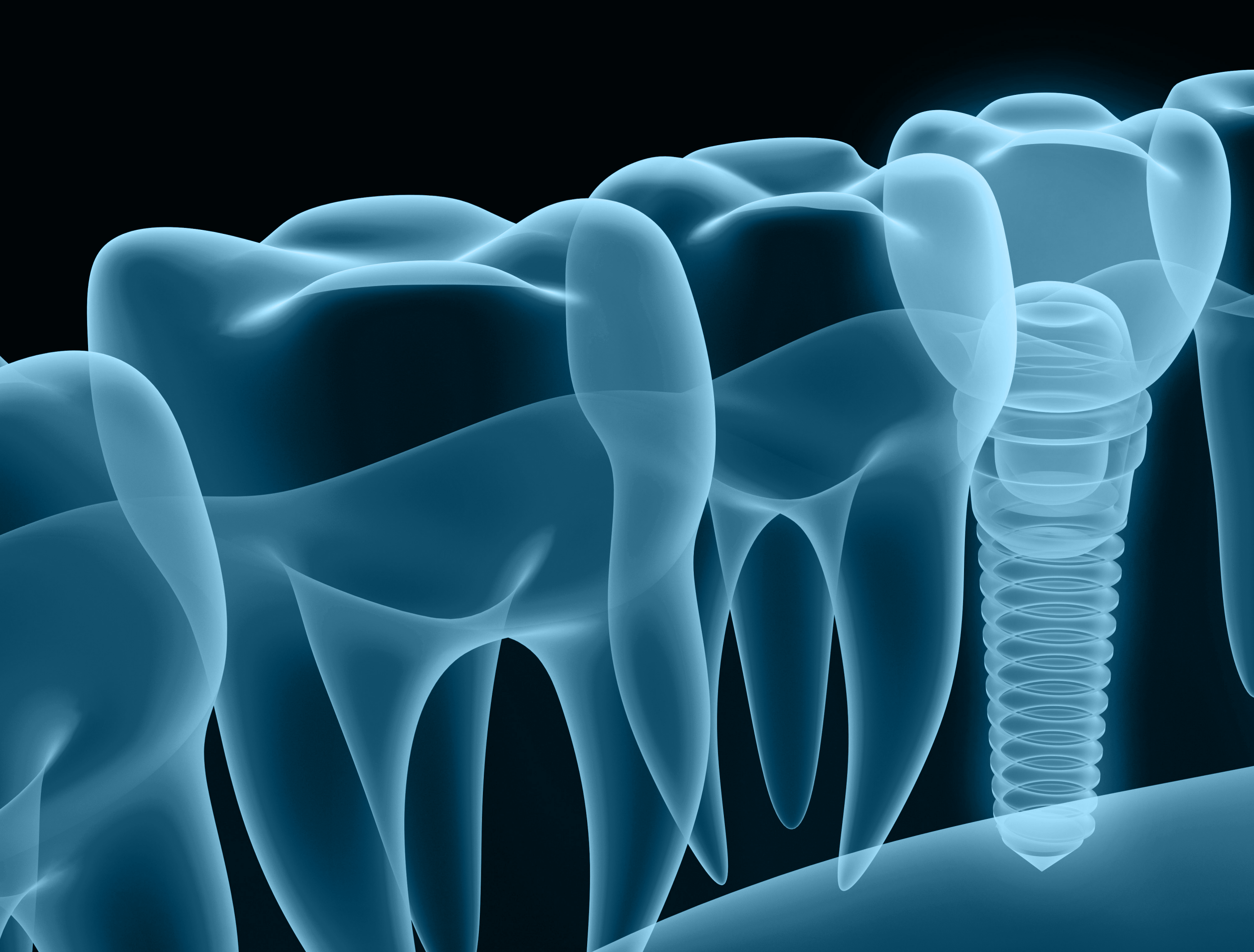


Patients with a completely edentulous jaw can now avoid the hassle associated with removable dentures.

A fixed full denture supported by several implants can give you back the look and feel of having teeth in your mouth again. It enables a much better quality of life, including better eating, talking and smiling.

- The denture is fixed in your mouth, not removable
- Improves appearance and self-esteem
- Helps prevent bone loss and jawline recession by replacing the tooth root

DOES THE OPERATION HURT?

The operation is painless and is performed under local anesthetic similar to any other dental procedure.

HOW LONG WILL THE IMPLANTS LAST?

Clinical research indicates a durability of over 25 years for dental rehabilitation using implants. Implants which have been inserted properly and which are maintained on a regular basis to keep them clean (regular checkups with the dentists and a dental hygienist and proper hygiene) last for many years.

DOES THE RECOVERY PROCESS CAUSE PAIN AND SWELLING?

Reactions vary from person to person. Most patients report minimal discomfort, with occasional light swelling that goes away after a day or two.

WILL I BE ABLE TO CHEW WITH THE IMPLANTS JUST AS I COULD WITH MY NATURAL TEETH?

Chewing efficiency and sensation are similar to those of natural teeth.

WHAT SHOULD I KNOW ABOUT THE IMPLANT?
